# CHESTATEE WAR EAGLE BASEBALL RULES & REGULATIONS

It is important that we establish the best possible understanding between players and coaches about their respective goals, responsibilities, commitments, procedures, and policies. It is equally important to understand the discipline that it will take in areas of academics, athletics, and your social life to earn the respect and success we want to achieve.

- I. The players general purpose for being a baseball player at Chestatee High School**
  - a. Ultimate Goals**
    - i. To make progress towards graduation and a high school diploma.**
    - ii. To contribute to a successful team.**
      - 1. Competitive Season Play**
      - 2. Aggressive Region Play (Championship)**
      - 3. State Appearances on regular basis (Championship)**
    - iii. To socially establish and practice quality living standards and develop lifelong friendships.**
  - b. Immediate Goals**
    - i. To reach your full potential as a team.**
    - ii. To reach your full potential as a person athletically and academically.**
      - 1. By making every effort to establish quality immediate goals each day and living up to those goals on a daily basis, we give ourselves the best opportunity to reach our ultimate goals.**
- II. The coaches' responsibilities are to help you reach your goals. In an effort to do the best possible job, we propose the following:**
  - a. Provide you with daily experiences on the field that will be conducive to learning, sharing, and proper team play along with individual growth and development.**
  - b. Monitor your academic responsibilities.**
  - c. Establish guidelines for off-the-field behavior and activities.**
- III. Disciplinary action will be taken when a team member does not meet the expectations and responsibilities discussed later in this outline.**
  - a. The penalty procedure is as follows: the penalty assigned will be determined by the head coach based on the seriousness and type of violation and the individual involved.**
  - b. Types of penalties:**
    - i. Physical activity as seen fit by coaching staff**
    - ii. Extra Field Work**
    - iii. Suspension**
    - iv. Termination**
- IV. Individual Expectations and Responsibilities**
  - a. On the field**
    - i. Report to games, practices, team meetings, and meetings with coaches on time. If you are going to be late or absent to anything, notify your coach prior for approval.**
    - ii. You must have permission to leave any team or individual session.**
    - iii. Hair, moustaches, sideburns, goatees, must be neatly trimmed. No beards.**
    - iv. Approved uniform will be worn for practices and games. Shoes and uniforms will be kept neat and clean.**
    - v. Socializing will be kept to a minimum any time you are on the baseball field. You will not be allowed to speak "through the fence" to any parent/friend/etc.**
    - vi. We will not vocalize, comment, or gesture in any way to opponents, fans, or umpires.**
      - 1. This includes parents from the stands. Your negative comments to our umpires do not help our team. Please let the coaches handle this. If you feel you need to continue to interact in any way with our umpires, the coach or administrator will have you removed from the field.**
    - vii. We will not use vulgar and/or abusive language.**
    - viii. We will not throw helmets, bats, or any equipment in disgust. Face adversity unemotionally.**
    - ix. Players and coaches understand they will share in the upkeep, preparation, and improvement of the field.**
    - x. The proper use of, storage of, and care of equipment and supplies will be the responsibility of players and coaches. Show respect to our equipment and locker room attendants at all times.**

- xi. Theft or horseplay involving any team or teammate's personal items or equipment will not be tolerated.
- xii. Report all injuries to a coach and update the coach on any restrictions you receive from a doctor/trainer.
- xiii. We will not tolerate anyone interfering with a teammate or coach trying to work.
- xiv. Display proper hustle and discipline at all times.
- xv. Keep the good of the team in mind at all times- be unselfish. Your positive attitude means more than your ability to the growth of our team.
- xvi. Handle your responsibilities and assignments, no matter how small they may seem, with pride and 100% effort.
- xvii. Be positive and respectful when talking about your team, your teammates, your coaches, and your school.
- xviii. Always think Safety First when on the field. Avoid situations that may set up an injury.
- xix. Respect all orders from school employees, including teachers, campus supervisors, other coaches, administrators, etc.

**b. Off the Field**

- i. Always be in good standing academically. GHSA eligible at all times.
- ii. Show respect to your teachers, administrators, and fellow students at all times.
- iii. Be on time and attend every class. Notify your teachers ahead of time if you will need to miss class for a game.
- iv. If you need to miss practices for academic purposes, discuss with coach ahead of time. Every effort should be made to handle these situations before school, lunch, after practice, etc.
- v. **If you are a discipline problem to a teacher, administrator, or any other school employee, then the coach will be involved and you will be dealt with severely. Out of School Suspension (OSS) – Hall County Regulation; No participation for days out & Coaches meeting. In School Suspension (ISS) – One game suspension; Coaches meeting. Any Detention Halls – Coaches meeting.**
- vi. Respect the baseball office and field as a place to conduct business.
- vii. Abide by the GHSA and CHS Athletic Handbook, and its rules and regulations.
- viii. Remember that as an athlete you are highly visible and conducting yourself so as to earn respect from others at all times, is important not only for our program but for you as an individual as well.

**KEEP IT SIMPLE:**

Be a responsible player and person; use common sense, be honest, be on time, and give 100% at all times.

**REMEMBER:**

Our final score will be determined by the degree of commitment we each make doing it the War Eagle way. "A great player can win a game; A great team can win every game."

# DUGOUT CLUB BY LAWS

## Article I – Purpose

This organization has been formed and shall exist for the primary purpose of promoting Parental Participation, support, sponsorship and interest in the Chestatee High School Baseball Program.

## Article II – Membership

- A. Regular membership in the booster club shall consist of individual members who enroll and pay dues, renewable each year in February or after teams are picked.
- B. The club officers shall establish annual dues.
- C. CHS Principle, Athletic Director, Head Coach and Assistant Coaches are exempt from payment of dues and shall have all the rights and privileges of individual membership.

## Article III – Meetings

- A. Regular meetings will be held the first Tuesday of every other month (starting on January 1 of new year) at 6:30pm in the Media Center. Meetings shall be rescheduled due to school holidays or game conflicts. Head Coach or the Club President reserve the right to call meetings when they feel necessary.
- B. All meetings are open to the general public, however, only current members in good standing will be permitted to vote and participate in Dugout Club Activities.

## Article IV - Officers and Their Election

- A. **Officers** - The officers of this club shall be:
  - 1. President
    - a. Shall be presiding officer of business meetings.
    - b. Shall assist in expediting of business.
    - c. Shall represent club to the Administration and/or Board of Education.
  - 2. Vice President
    - a. Shall assist the President or preside in the absence of the President.
  - 3. Secretary/Treasurer
    - a. Shall record minutes of the business meeting.
    - b. Shall be custodian of minutes and other records.
    - c. Shall handle all correspondence
    - d. Call parents to remind them about upcoming meetings, etc.
    - e. Shall record and deposit club funds.
    - f. Shall pay all monthly bills on approval.
    - g. Shall give a concise, up-to-date financial report at each regular meeting.
    - h. Call parents to remind them about upcoming meetings, etc.
- I. **Term of Office** - Officers shall take office for a period of one year starting on May 1<sup>st</sup> and ending on April 30<sup>th</sup>. Officers must take an active role in the activities of the club.
- II. **Election** - Nominations to be made from the floor during the March meeting. Election of officers will take place at the regular meeting during the month of April. Newly elected Officers will start May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- III. **Outgoing Officers Responsibilities**: It shall be the responsibility of all outgoing Officers to make themselves available and council all newly elected officers as to their office responsibilities and all knowledge of the Dugout Club activities so that a smooth transition takes place,

## Article V - Amendments of the Bylaws

- A. May be amended at the every other month meetings – follow up meeting is required.
  - 1. During the first meeting the proposal shall be read and recorded in the minutes.

2. During the second meeting, the proposal shall be read and a vote from the members present shall be taken.
  - a. Passage will require a majority vote.
3. Upon passage, amendment shall be recorded in the Bylaws.

## **Article VI - Payment of Expenditures**

- A. All claims to be paid by check or cash with receipt.
  1. Signatures:
    - a. Treasurer
    - b. And/or Head Coach
- B. The President, Vice President, Treasurer and Head Coach shall approve all expenditures.

## **Article VII – Support Committees Responsibilities**

**Development of Bylaws** – Develop draft of bylaws to be presented at upcoming meeting.

**Fundraising**- Coordinate fundraising activities approved by Club and Principle. This may include Signs, Raffles and all activities necessary to support budget.

**Concessions** – Coordinate all activities involving start up and operation of the concession stand during JV and Varsity games.

**Banquet** – Coordinate year end banquet to include – Location, Menu, Video, Decorations, Agenda, player awards, coaches gifts, parent gifts, etc.

**Gate** – Coordinate collection of fees for Freshman, JV and Varsity games.

**Senior Night** – Coordinate Senior Night activities to include senior awards, Biographies, etc.

**Press Box** – Coordinate Press Box activities to include: National Anthem, Walkout songs, Scoreboard and announcements.

**Away Game Meals** – Coordinate away game meals to include: Parent volunteers for each away game, finding a sponsor or discounted place to get meals

**Budget** – Develop yearly budget based on Head Coaches recommendations.

## **Article VIII – Lay Coaches**

Lay Coaches shall be paid each season an amount recommended by the Head Coach and approved by the Dugout Club Members.

## **Article IX – Executive Committee**

- A. The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary/Treasurer, Head Coach, Principle and Athletic Director.
- B. The Executive Committee shall meet on call by the President.
- C. A minimum of four members of the Executive Committee must be present for business to be conducted.
- D. The Executive Committee shall oversee all activities of the War Eagle Dugout Club.
- E. Principle, Athletic Director and Head Coach reserve the right to over turn decisions that they deem to be not in the best interest of Chestatee High School and/or the Baseball program.
